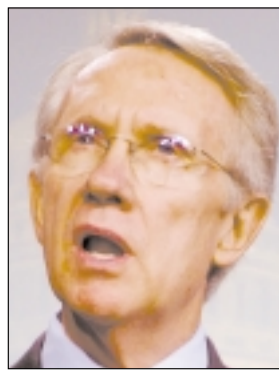


The Reid connections

The senator



Harry Reid, 63, senior senator from Nevada, first elected in 1986; assistant minority leader; member of Appropriations Committee; vice chairman of the Ethics Committee; vice chairman of the Ethics committee

The sons, all of whom are lawyers at Lionel, Sawyer & Collins, Nevada's largest law firm



Rory Reid, 40, graduate of Brigham Young University law school; only politician among the sons so far; elected member of the Clark County Board of Commissioners; former chairman of Nevada state Democratic Party



Leif Reid, 35, graduate of Stanford Law School, a litigator; former assistant U.S. attorney; Republican senator from Nevada recently put Leif's name among possible nominees for federal court vacancy



Josh Reid, 31, graduate of University of Arizona law school; holds a master's in environmental science from Yale



Key Reid, 28, graduate of George Mason University School of Law; former star midfielder on University of Virginia soccer team; lobbyist in firm's Washington office

Steven Barringer, 47, graduate of Brigham Young law school; married to Reid's only daughter; principal in government-relations consulting firm McClure, Gerard & Neuenschwander since November 2000; lawyer at Dickstein Shapiro Morin & Oshinsky from April 1999 to October 2000

Howard Hughes Corp.

What Sen. Reid has done

Sponsored legislation that gave the company 998 acres of prime Las Vegas real estate through a federal land swap.

How much family members' firms have been paid*

\$300,000 to the McClure firm for Barringer and others to lobby



City of Henderson

Sponsored legislation that freed 4,000 acres of federal land for development and annexation near Henderson.

\$220,000 to the McClure firm for Barringer and others to lobby



City of Las Vegas and city of North Las Vegas

Sponsored legislation that freed 18,000 acres for development and annexation by the two cities.

\$40,000 paid by Las Vegas and \$100,000 by North Las Vegas to the Lionel Sawyer firm for Key Reid and others to lobby



Pershing County Water Reclamation District

Helped push legislation that allowed federal land to be transferred to local irrigation district.

\$80,000 to the McClure firm for Barringer and others to lobby



Coyote Springs, a real estate development project headed by Harvey Whittemore

Sponsored legislation that would have moved a federal power line easement off the property Whittemore wants to develop, freeing up to 11,000 acres for a new subdivision. Reid dropped the measure after the Los Angeles Times and Senate staffers raised questions.

Reid's four sons all work with Whittemore, who is a senior partner at Lionel Sawyer



The proposed Meadow Valley Generating Plant, developed by PG&E National Energy Group

Sponsored legislation that allows them to put a pipeline through a part of what had been protect protected wilderness area.

Undisclosed amount to the Lionel Sawyer firm for Rory and others to lobby in Nevada

American Gaming Assn.

What Sen. Reid has done

Has been a tireless supporter of gaming industry. Fought against legislative efforts to impose a nationwide ban on wagering on college sports, which is legal only in Nevada

How much family members' firms have been paid*

\$30,000 to the Dickstein firm for Barringer and others to lobby
\$180,000 to the McClure firm for Barringer and others to lobby



Nevada Resort Assn., the state casino trade group

Challenged tribal gaming outside Nevada that threatened to cut into the state's gaming business. Fought proposed ban on college-sports betting

Undisclosed amount to the Lionel Sawyer firm for Leif and Rory Reid to represent the resort association and the Nevada Mining Assn.



Mining

The special interest

National Mining Assn., the mining industry trade group

What Sen. Reid has done

Had been a steady advocate in the Senate for hard-rock mining. Fought attempts to replace century-old, \$5-an-acre charge for extracting minerals from federal lands with a sizeable royalty payment. Delayed or modified the federal government's tough new environmental and land-use rules for mining on federal lands.

\$320,000 to the McClure firm for Barringer and others to lobby

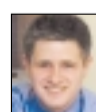
University of Nevada at Reno

What Sen. Reid has done

Helped the school secure millions of dollars in specially earmarked funds in his work on the Senate Appropriations Committee.

How much family members' firms have been paid*

\$10,000 a month to the Lionel Sawyer firm for lobbying by Barringer and former Sen. Richard Bryan



Kerr-McGee Corp.

Helped the oil and chemical company get federal funds to help pay to clean up radioactive waste at a company plant near Chicago.

Undisclosed amount to the Lionel Sawyer firm for Rory Reid and others to lobby in Nevada



Heli USA Airways, a leading Grand Canyon tour operator

Opposed federal attempts to restrict Grand Canyon tours.

\$20,000 to the Dickstein firm for Barringer and others to lobby



Air Products & Chemicals Inc.

Backed a \$10.8-million public-private partnership between the company and federal government to build a hydrogen filling station for buses.

Undisclosed amount of the Lionel Sawyer firm for Rory Reid and others to lobby in Nevada



Nevada Test Development Site Corp.

Helped funnel millions of dollars in federal funds to develop the test site.

\$20,000 to the McClure firm for Barringer and others to lobby federal agencies
