University School senior
Ht.: 6-4; **Wt.:** 300
Pos.: OL
Comment: A two-way player and Under-Armour All-American, Bain had 10 pancake blocks and 20 knockdowns on offensive line, and surrendered just one sack.



JORDAN BUDWIG
University School senior
Ht.: 6-5; **Wt.:** 310
Pos.: OL
Comment: Two-time first-team selection consistently graded out as Suns' best offensive lineman. Had 32 pancake blocks, 17 knockdowns and allowed just one sack.



JORDAN CUNNINGHAM
University School senior
Ht.: 6-2; **Wt.:** 180
Pos.: WR
Comment: A three-time first-team selection, captain and an Under Armour All-American, he had 53 catches for 817 yards and eight touchdowns.

Comment: Three-year starter helped paved the way for Dillard's rushing attack and was impressive in pass blocking as well.

Comment: Two-year starter rushed 175 times for 1,357 yards (7.8 per carry) and 22 touchdowns and caught 10 passes for 56 yards.



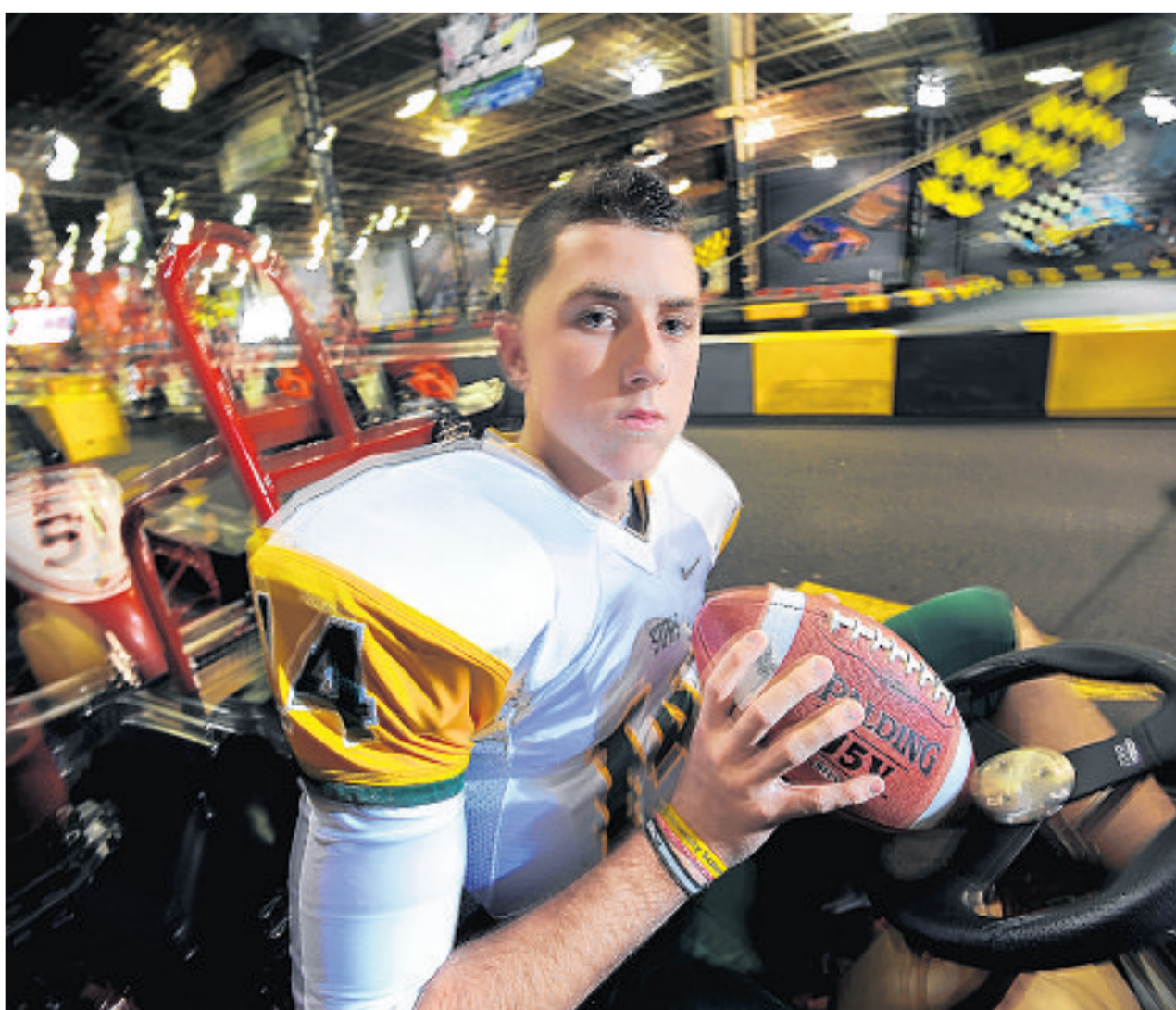
KADEEM SMITH

Season highlights

White completed 25-of-30 passes for 326 yards and two touchdowns against Clearwater Central Catholic in the state semifinals and 21 of 31 for 282 yards and two touchdowns in a 24-17 victory over Madison County for the Class 3A championship.

Comment

White, who verbally committed to South Florida after winning the title, was named the state's Class 3A Player of the Year by Florida Dairy Farmers. Also a baseball standout who started at University School as a sixth-grader, White wasn't assured of the starting quarterback job entering spring ball prior to his senior year. He erased any doubts that he could lead an offense loaded with playmakers as he proved an efficient passer who took care of the ball and made big plays with his arm. Consequently, he received increasing attention from colleges. "We strongly believe that good things happen for good people that fixate their efforts on working hard, and Mike is the epitomy of that,"

"This season was enormous for the school as a whole, and the community. This is what we've been working for ever since we started this program. My personal success is a tribute to the job my teammates around me did. I couldn't have done any of it without my offensive linemen. They're great. I couldn't ask for a better group of guys."

Suns coach Roger Harriott said. "He demonstrated some real resolve and was able to stay poised in difficult circumstances. The most impressive thing about Mike is his ability to lead in pressure and adverse situations." White credited his teammates - on offense and defense - for his success. "One thing people always say about me is that I'm a baseball player playing football," White said. "That kind of got to me so I wanted to prove that I'm a football player playing football. I'm a quarterback. I finally got my chance and I made the most of it."
