## DETAILS:

On April 17, 2015, at approximately 1633 hours, I, Detective Meegan, P#4117, and Officer J. White, P#8935, were operating as overtime unit 26SE at the Wet Republic Pool, MGM Grand.

We were contacted by Wet Republic Pool security that they had a white male adult in custody, later identified with a California driver's license as Jarret Stoll, date of birth [REDACTED]. Stoll consented to a voluntary patdown upon entrance to the Wet Republic Pool by security. It should be noted that there is a posted sign that the Wet Republic security will ask to do a patdown in that area. Security guard Marc James found an off-white powder in two pink baggies, small baggies, he recognized as contraband, also a clear plastic baggie containing numerous gel-caps with an off white powder inside the caps.

The contraband was in the right, back pocket of Jarret Stoll's swimsuit shorts. Once in the security office of the pool, I spoke with Stoll, who provided his California driver's license. I immediately recognized from my training and experience having been a narcotics detective for the past 20 years the off-white powder in pink baggie to be consistent with the illegal narcotic cocaine. The gel-caps with the power inside were consistent with the illegal narcotic MDMA or street term "Molly."

I conducted an ODV test of the off-white powder in the pink baggie, which tested positive for cocaine, gross weight being 3.3 grams. The gel-caps had a gross weight of 8.1 grams. At approximately 1644 hours, I read

Stoll his rights per Miranda, and he stated he understood. I asked him if the powder in the pink baggies was cocaine, and he stated, "Yes." Stoll was placed under arrest for possession of a controlled substance cocaine.

The MDMA or "Molly" was booked into evidence along with the cocaine under event number 150417-3150 pending a chemical analysis. Stoll was transported to Clark County Detention Center where he was booked accordingly by the prisoner transport van, Officer Ruiz. Both the items were booked into evidence as package one, item one, and package 2, item 2, that being the cocaine and the "Molly."
