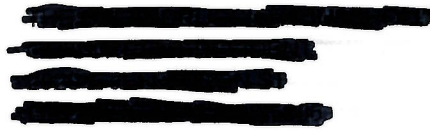

Paulson For Mayor... A New Mayor, for a Change!

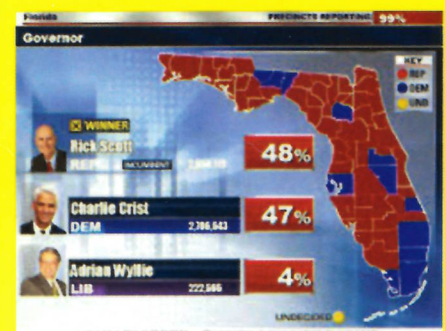
Is "Buddy" Dyer our Buddy?
